REIMAGINING MILLER MIDDLE SCHOOL

B.R. Miller Middle School has served generations of students and has been a source of immense pride for nearly a century. However, the needs today of students and staff and the expectations of public education have changed dramatically since this school first opened its doors in 1925.

Among the many facility challenges the Marshalltown Community School District faces today when it comes to MMS are inadequate safety measures and security systems, limited technology capabilities, and a lack of space for learning, gathering, and new programming, among others.

On **Tuesday, November 5, 2024**, our community will consider a \$57 million bond referendum. If it is approved by at least 60% of voters, MCSD will move forward with a series of improvements at MMS that reimagine the historic facility for generations to come.



ELECTION DAY: NOVEMBER 5, 2024

- » Voters will consider a **general obligation bond of up to \$57 million**.
- » An approved bond referendum would have an annual tax impact of **\$112.43 on a home with an assessed value of \$200,000**.
- » Bond referendums require **60% approval** to pass.

ABSENTEE VOTING

- » Registered voters can now request a **mailed absentee ballot** from the Marshall County Auditor's Office. Ballots will be sent out beginning October 17.
- » **In-person absentee voting** begins October 16 at the county auditor's office, located on the third floor of the Marshall County Courthouse. This will be available weekdays until November 4.
